## **Top of Mind Agronomic Topics**

As 2023 comes to a close, there remain many agronomic discussion points going into 2024. We could write an entire article on each of the topics below but here are some short thoughts that have been top of mind for our advisors and growers going into the new year.

- 1. **Crop Protection** Pre-emerge chemistry popularity is increasing; how does this effect our application/sprayer and planting logistics in the spring?
- 2. **Crop Rotations** Winter wheat stands looked great going into dormancy, how may this affect your management strategy in the spring? Could the use of growth regulators be more relevant to manage the standability and yield potential of these winter cereal stands.
- 3. **Soil Sample Results** Organic matter is typically one of the 1<sup>st</sup> discussion points of a soil sample, why is this? How does your soil's organic matter compare to others? Do you have an organic matter build strategy?
- 4. **Fertility** Nutrient stewardship is becoming a foremost concern when applying macro nutrients (N, P, K) both as commercial fertilizer and manure. Are you working within the stewardship guidelines and maximizing farm yield potential?

Stage Two, the bag production area and warehouse are to be completed by end of March and is on schedule that we can start packaging by mid-February. ## Fertilizer Market Update

After spring markets had seen significant resets which were well needed to align with the grain market with small escalation over the summer with all products. Currently -

The nitrogen market, both global and domestic, is staying soft waiting for buyers to start movement over the winter months for spring needs. Seems to be a slight discount for Urea over UAN. Some concerns going into winter are the conflict in the Middle East and higher gas prices in European production areas.

Phosphates had had some rebound over the summer months and today reflect higher than fall application values. There has been tight inventory over the fall months globally with good ground application right across North America.

Potash prices remain steady with three small increases since summer when we booked our fall needs which has been good value for those that have completed their fall work. There has been strong demand and record sales for both Nutrien and Mosaic this past season. This has created tighter supply going into fall as we wait for winter fill programs. We would suggest you stay connected with your agronomist over the winter months and keep your crop budgets updated.
